6-Month Curriculum Overview

Program Structure

This 6-month program is designed for aspiring upholsterers and entrepreneurs. It provides hands-on upholstery training, foundational business knowledge, and Kingdom-based personal development. Training occurs 2 days per week, with each session lasting approximately 5 to 6 hours.

Month 1 – Foundation & Frame Building (10 Days)

- • Intro Module: Kingdom Values for Life & Business – 1 Day
- • Module M0: Safety & Tool Handling – 3 Day
- • Module M1: Frame Design & Fabrication – 6 Days

Month 2 – Materials & Support Systems (6 Days)

- • Module M2: Materials Science – 2 Days
- • Module M3: Webbing & Springs – 4 Days

Month 3 – Padding & Pattern Drafting (7 Days)

- • Module M4: Padding, Foaming & Shaping – 4 Days
- • Module M5: Pattern Drafting & Cutting – 3 Days

Month 4 – Sewing & Finishing (9 Days)

- • Module M6: Sewing Techniques – 6 Days
- • Module M7: Upholstering & Decorative Finishing – 3 Days

Month 5 – Quality, Repairs & Business Skills (8 Days)

- • Module M8: Quality Control & Repairs – 2 Days
- • Module M9: Business & Entrepreneurship – 6 Days

Month 6 – Capstone Project & Graduation (8 Days)

- • Capstone Project: Full Upholstery Rebuild & Presentation – 8 Days
